How to Enable OpenType Features (Ligatures, Alternates)

Use these steps to access special OpenType features like Stylistic Alternates, Ligatures, and Swashes in your design software.

1. Adobe Illustrator

- Select Text.
- Go to Window in the main menu bar.
- Scroll down to the Type category and select OpenType.
- Quick Shortcut: If the panel is open, you can also press Ctrl + Shift + T (Windows) or Cmd + Shift + T (Mac) to open the Character panel, and the OpenType options are often grouped with it.
- Click the icons in the OpenType panel to toggle features (e.g., Standard Ligatures, Contextual Alternates, Swashes).
- To insert specific alternates: Go to Window > Type > Glyphs. Double-click the desired alternate character to insert it.

2. Adobe Photoshop

- Select Text Layer and activate the Type Tool (T).
- Go to Window > OpenType (or Window > Character).
- Click the icons in the OpenType panel that appears to toggle features (e.g., Ligatures, Stylistic Sets).
- To insert specific alternates: Go to Window > Glyphs. Double-click the desired alternate character.

3. Microsoft Word

- Select Text.
- Go to the Home tab, and click the small arrow in the bottom-right of the Font section to open the detail box.

- Go to the Advanced tab.
- Use the Ligatures dropdown menu and select "All".
- If available, select the desired Stylistic Set number. (Note: Word cannot manually insert all individual alternate characters.)
