How to Use the Fonts and Alternates on Windows, Mac, Word, Publisher, Cricut, Silhouette, etc.

➤ **Windows – Word, Publisher, Photoshop, Cricut, Silhouette, etc.**

There are two ways to use these fonts in Cricut:

1. Using OTF or TTF

- Install the font on your computer.
- Open Cricut Design Space, click on the text icon, then go to the font dropdown menu.
- Select the “System” tab and find the font you just installed.

2. Using SVG Files

- Upload the SVG file.
- Ungroup the text elements.
- You’re all set!

To access swashes, alternates, or glyph on Windows, you can use **Character Map**:

- Open the Start menu and search for **Character Map**.
- Select the installed font.
- Enable **Advanced View** and choose **Unicode Subrange**.
- Select **Private Use Characters** to find alternates and swashes.
- Copy and paste the selected glyph into your design program (Word, Cricut, Silhouette, etc.).

For **Microsoft Word 2010 and later**:

- Select the font and go to **Insert > More Symbols**.
- Choose **Private Use Area** and pick the glyph you need.
- Click **Insert** to add it to your design.

Tip for MS Word Users: Ensure that **Kerning for fonts** is enabled for optimal letter spacing.

➤ **Mac – Word, Publisher, Cricut, Photoshop, Silhouette, etc.**

On Mac, you can access swashes and alternates using **Font Book**:

- Open **Font Book** (use Spotlight search to find it).
- Select the font and switch to **Repertoire View** (click the small grid/dots icon or go to **View > Repertoire**).
- Copy and paste the desired glyph into your design software (Word, Cricut, Silhouette, etc.).

➤ **Using Fonts on iPhone or iPad**

To install fonts on an iPhone or iPad, you can use **iFont** (available in the App Store):

- Open **iFont** and go to the **Files** tab.
- Click **Import**, locate the font file, and select it.
- If the font is in a ZIP folder, tap the folder to unzip and extract the font file.
- Click **Import to iFont**.
- Go to your **Device Settings > Profile Downloaded**, then click **Install**.
- Your font is now ready to use!
